
## To automatically setup your desktop Mac Mail application

- 1. Login to <a href="https://mail.terradatacenters.com">https://mail.terradatacenters.com</a> with your email address and credentials
- 2. At the first page, you will find options to select a profile to download.



- 3. Choose which profile you want and the further options of Email/Calendars and Contacts. If you are not sure, we recommend **Apple connection profile with app password and Email** only. If you are going to store calendars and contacts on the mail server which will sync with all other devices connected, then you would select **Email, calendars and contacts**.
- 4. This profile when clicked will prompt to download to a location, we recommend your **Desktop** or **Downloads** directory.
- 5. Open Finder and navigate to the directory you downloaded the profile named **Mail Administration.mobileconfig** and double click this file.
- 6. A notification will popup to review the profile.




7. Open your System Settings

- 13. If you selected calendars and contacts as well, then the Mac Calendar and Mac Contacts will also be automatically configured.
